This bears reference to Draft of Battery Waste Management Rules released on 20<sup>th</sup> February 2020 in supersession of the Batteries (Management and Handling) Rules, 2001. We would like to bring to your kind notice that all of our members (i.e. electronics industry) are signatory to EPR framework which includes batteries

In this context, we wish to seek clarity from MoEF&CC on <u>non-inclusion of "finished</u> <u>electronics products that includes batteries as a consumable" in Draft Battery Waste Rules</u> as they are already covered under the E-Waste EPR framework.

A line in confirmation on the same will greatly help in understanding the compliance requirements by the electronics industry.
